The Commission requested the recording secretary to draft up a letter to Charter Communications asking them for a contact name and phone number, along with requesting Spectrum to resolve the complaint at 6830 Hidden Lake.

Franchise Fees

The commission reviewed the 1st quarter fees for 2018 and determined that fees showed an increase from last year.

Open Forum

Councilman Broski spoke briefly about a few current events in the City such as the deed for the VA property has been filed. The police station will hopefully open in the spring of 2019.
