Franchise Fees

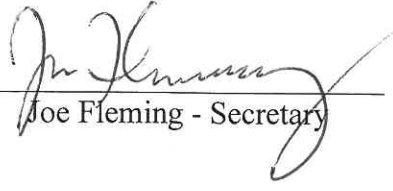
The commission reviewed the 1st quarter fees for 2017 and determined that fees remained about the same.

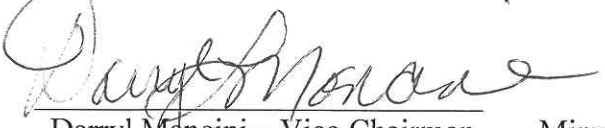
Open Forum
