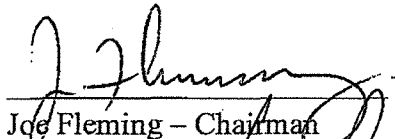
No new complaints were received.

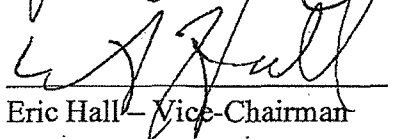
Franchise Fees
