**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the publication of bids according to law, bids for the furnishing of various types of asphalt for road repairs in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing, were received and opened according to law on March 3, 2026, and it being determined that the bid of Kokosing Materials, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** Per the bids received and as tabulated by the Director of Purchasing, the bid of Kokosing Materials, Inc. dated March 3, 2026, for Virgin Binder Materials, the furnishing of Asphalt Concrete Base in the amount of \$72.20 per ton, Asphalt Concrete Intermediate Course, Type 2, in the amount of \$74.70 per ton, Asphalt Concrete Intermediate Course, Type 1 in the amount of \$83.10 per ton, and Asphalt Concrete Surface Course, Type 1, in the amount of \$83.20 per ton; for Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) Materials, the furnishing of Asphalt Concrete Base, in the amount of \$61.00 per ton, Asphalt Concrete Intermediate Course, Type 2, in the amount of \$62.20 per ton, Asphalt Concrete Intermediate Course, Type 1 in the amount of \$68.45 per ton, and Asphalt Concrete Surface Course, Type 1, in the amount of \$69.45 per ton, plus applicable delivery charges at \$10.82 per ton, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing, be and the same is hereby accepted.
