RECREATION DIRECTOR REPORT:

Recreation Director Tom Tupa reported at the last council meeting new pool umbrellas and the "Inflatable" Movie screen were approved. He stated that the old movie screen would go for auction.

The recreation center purchased two (2) recumbent bikes and two (2) upright bikes with the Corporate Membership Funds. Currently up to 73 Corporate Members with 500 memberships available.

Tupa mentioned they would be mulching this week and next, Kids Quarters being done on Tuesday. Fields and surrounding areas look great!

The new service garage foundation is being leveled this week, with hopes of having it fully functional by November.

The School District and City of Brecksville have come to a joint agreement to utilize the Highland Drive Elementary Field as another Baseball Field. Tupa stated that all pricing is done. He is not sure exactly when the start date will be, but stated that the City of Brecksville will maintain this field and it will

have similar dimensions to Diamond E at Blossom but with no outfield fence since it is on school property.

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Pete Kormos reported all summer camps are going extremely well!

Nanci Schlabilg reported there are currently 233 Runners registered for the Home Days Home Run 5K and 25 runners/walkers for the 1 Mile run/walk. Schlabilg stated shirts are being printed on Tuesday 6/25/13.
