RECREATION DIRECTOR REPORT:

Recreation Director Tom Tupa reported approximately 200 people attended the Summer Concert on Sunday featuring The PopTarts.

Tupa reported he will be reviewing membership rates at the next meeting. He will be showing comparisons to other communities and how much of a difference there is.

Stucky recommended that the entire Commission attend the presentation. Tupa announced he would let everyone know once a date has been set.
