RECREATION DIRECTOR REPORT:

Recreation Director Tom Tupa reported on the following:

- 3. Memorial Day Parade kicks off Monday at 9am.**

Athletic Director Pete Kormos reported he has been getting positive remarks from parents about the Community Center offering a discount to campers who also sign up for a learn-to-swim program during the same week. Kormos stated baseball and camp are both maxed out. Kormos reported they have held a few 5th & 6th Grade Lacrosse games at Blossom. One game was on the turf field, one on the grass and the final game will be played on the turf field on May 30th. Kormos also said they are looking to possibly add a Lacrosse Camp at the end of summer/early fall for 3rd - 6th graders.
